- Competition Format:** Written (with both Chinese and English version)
- Competition Content:** 70% fundamental mathematics, 30% Mathematical Olympiad
- Competition Date:** 8th December 2024 (Sunday)
- Competition Venue:** AMO - Unit 824-825, 8/F, Middle Block, Star House, 3 Salisbury Road, Tsim Sha Tsui KLN, Hong Kong
- Competition Time:** 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.
(Time allowed is about 45 minutes to 1 hour, including time for distribution and collection of the papers)
- Report Time:** Students must report their attendance before 15 minutes of the competition time or they will be disqualified.

Entry Notice:

1. The official admission forms will be issued via WhatsApp on or before 18 November 2024. If you do not receive your admission forms after this date, please contact us immediately.
2. We will not accept any request related to not receiving the official admission forms after 28 November 2024.

Competition Arrangement:

1. Students should bring along their admission forms, handbooks or academic certificates with their photographs to the competition venue.
2. Participants cannot hand in the paper or leave the venue early, except for any special circumstance.
3. No stationery will be provided. Students should prepare pencils and rubbers.
4. Participants cannot use any calculation aiding tools during the competition.
5. All competition papers will not be returned. The decision of final results will be solely made by HKMIA.

Assessment Guideline and Award

1. A medal and certificate will be awarded to the Champion, 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up, 3rd runner-up and 4th runner-up (1 in each form).
2. “Outstanding Award”, the school with the highest average score of the students will receive the Outstanding School Award trophy.
3. “Most Actively Participating School Award”, the school with the highest number of students participating will be awarded the “Most Actively Participating School Award” trophy.

Remarks and Statements:

1. The information of each student must be filled in carefully. After submitting the registration forms, the student information cannot be changed.
2. After registration, the contact teacher will receive admission forms printed with each student’s name. Students are required to join the competition with their admission forms, handbooks or academic certificates with their photographs.
3. The results of the competition will be announced on the HKMIA website in late January. Award certificates will be mailed to their schools one month after the announcement of the competition results.
4. HKMIA reserves the right to make final decisions on all related matters.
